*\*Three equal payments for the All Access Pass is available. Balance must be paid in full on or before November 30, 2011*

- Fees will be prorated for any skater joining OFS after October 15, 2011. Please contact league office for details.

The Drop-In OFS fee for 2011-2012 will be \$13.00 per session for skaters not choosing a contract or a punch card. The drop-in fee will be paid at the session before skater enters the ice.

The Open Figure Skating season will be October 1, 2011 through April 19, 2012. Please see the attached OFS season schedule for specific information on dates and times for OFS sessions. Whenever possible, additional OFS sessions will be offered. All attempts will be made to keep the OFS session schedule consistent throughout the season but understand that situations do arise during the season that will require schedule changes and/or cancelling of OFS sessions.

**REFUNDS:** A full refund of all fees paid will be granted prior to October 1, 2011. After this date, refunds will only be given for a skater who sustains a season-ending injury or who moves out of the immediate area. In such instance, a written request for refund explaining the reason for the request must be provided to the league office. A prorated amount will be issued for the unused portion of the OFS contract.

No refunds are available for punch passes.

No refunds will be given to a skater who is denied access to OFS sessions due to their failure to follow session rules.

## **OCTOBER 1 – APRIL 19 MORNING SCHEDULE:**

**Morning sessions: 6:00 – 7:00 AM**

**Each week Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday**

**Exceptions: Thanksgiving and approximately 3 Fridays due to other arena events –  
exact dates TBA**

## **OCTOBER 1 – 31 AFTERNOON SCHEDULE:**

**Each Week Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday @ 4:30-5:45 pm (one hour, 15  
minute sessions)**

## **NOVEMBER 1 – APRIL 19:**

**Afternoon Sessions: 4:30 – 5:30 PM**

**Each Week Monday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday**

**Exceptions: thanksgiving, December 26-30 and some Fridays due to other  
arena events – exact dates affected TBA**

# OFS EXPECTATIONS AND CODE OF CONDUCT

- ❖ All skaters will sign-in at skate room before getting on the ice.
- ❖ If skater is using the OFS punch card system, the punch card must be presented to rink employee before getting on the ice.
- ❖ The drop-in fee for skaters not having an All-Access Pass or a punch card is \$13.00 per session.
- ❖ Skater will NOT be allowed access to any OFS session without payment or OFS pass.
- ❖ Access to morning OFS sessions must be arranged through coaches Kathie Jewell, Leslie Albright or Lisa Grasso.

## COACHES:

- ❖ All coaches must purchase a Coaches season pass.
- ❖ Visiting coaches may teach private lessons on OFS ice with prior approval from the league office. Proof of insurance will be required.
- ❖ All coaches must provide proof of insurance with Centennial Ice Arena listed as an additional insured before accessing any OFS session.

## ON-ICE:

- ❖ On ice training aids will be allowed only for those that remain in a coaches control at all times during the session (such as a jumping harness).
- ❖ Props for programs will be allowed. Respect for the safety of other skaters on the ice must be considered at all times while using a prop. A prop is only allowed on the ice while skater is practicing a program. Skater must be able to keep any prop under control at all times and must also be able to bring the prop onto an off the ice under his/her own power.
- ❖ Keep moving at all times! Socializing should be done off the ice. Do not stay in one area while practicing – other skaters will want to use this space as well.
- ❖ Skater Right-of-Way: 1. Program in a lesson, 2. Lesson, 3. Program, 4. Skater entering a jump or spin. Coaches and skaters shall respect right-of-way at all times. Coaches are responsible for teaching their students the right-of-way system and teaching common patterns so younger/new skaters can anticipate change of directions, etc. so they can be safe on the ice and not hinder other skaters. Skaters unable to stay out of the way, who do not learn to move when necessary or who are unable to learn patterns may have their OFS privileges revoked.
- ❖ Music: Please be respectful to all skaters on the session with music to play. Each skater should expect their music to play a minimum of two times per session. Back-to-back program play is not allowed unless you are in a lesson. While in a lesson, you may have your music played twice.
- ❖ Spins should be warmed up and practiced in the center of the ice (except for program practice).
- ❖ If you witness a skater who's actions are a possible threat to the safety of others, please notify a coach and the rink employee. The rink employee must document the incident with skater and witness names for follow-up.
- ❖ If you witness a safety issue related to the ice, please notify the rink employee immediately.

## PARENTS:

- ❖ Please make sure your skater arrives with proper payment in the form of a pass, punch card or the drop-in fee. Skater will be denied access without payment.
- ❖ No parent is allowed on the ice during an OFS session unless they are a paying skater themselves.
- ❖ Coaching from the sideboards or off the ice is not allowed. Parents are not allowed on the "hockey bench" side of the arena.
- ❖ Disruptive behavior may result in denied access to the arena during OFS sessions. Continued misbehavior may result in your skater being denied access to OFS sessions.

## INJURY:

- ❖ If a serious injury occurs on the ice, do not attempt to move or assist the skater off the ice. If the injured skater cannot stand up under their own power, notify the rink employee and a coach immediately.
